EMU Students Take First Step to Create DSCT Student Chapter

On February 6, members of the Detroit Society for Coatings Technology (DSCT) presented the benefits of becoming a member of the Federation of Society for Coatings Technology (FSCT) in a presentation to the students of the Polymers and Coatings curriculum of the School of Engineering Technology at Eastern Michigan University.
